Featured Dance of the Month **LINDY HOP SWING**

The first dances named as Lindy Hop were born around the time the aviator Charles Lindbergh made his groundbreaking flight across the Atlantic Ocean in May 1927. Frankie Manning was part of a new generation of Lindy hoppers, and is the most celebrated Lindy hopper in history. Lindy hop entered mainstream American culture in the 1930s. Lindy hop today is danced as a social dance, as a competitive dance and as a performance dance. In each, partners may dance alone or together, with improvisation being a central part of social dancing and many performance and competition pieces.
