December 2015 Happy Holidays and Highlights of 2015 Survey!

The Board members of Ballroom Dance Charleston and I wish each of you a safe and happy holiday. Whether you are celebrating Christmas, Hanukkah or other, the holiday season with it's message of love, caring, and



generosity towards others is a wonderful time of the year. The holidays are not always easy for many, but still they are an opportunity for joy, forgiveness and compassion. Having all of you as part of my "Dance Family" is a blessing I am extremely thankful for.

This is a very busy time of the year and getting to the annual meeting may be an event not yet on your calendar. The annual meeting is Saturday, Dec 19th at 2 pm, at the main library on Calhoun Street. Parking is usually not a problem as the library has its own parking facility. Your input, your suggestions and questions are welcome all year and especially at this meeting as we report on the "State of the first year at Pier Pont for BDC".

One of the highlights of the meeting will be the member's input from the 2015 Survey. All the results and comments on the survey are available for members to read but -as promised-here are the highlights from the survey.

Who responded? 54 members, (4 non-members completed the survey but their answers are not included here)

How long had the respondents been members? 44% had been members more than five years, 40% had been members longer than 5 years

Main reason for participation at BDC?: To dance at the parties (65%) Number of members enrolled in weekly classes: 60% Those in favor of maintaining Friday night progressive classes as is: 47% Members interested In Sunday Tea Dances: 68% (monthly and occasionally) Member interest in a Performance Team: 21% yes, 29% maybe, 32% no Best Number for Special Parties per month: Two-32%, One-35% Members in favor of staggered terms for Board members: 79%

We will be providing a comprehensive response and plan as a result of the survey. Many of the questions do not lend themselves to abbreviated percentages so you need to come to the meeting and hear plans for 2016 at Ballroom Dance Charleston!
