New classes for February

The Ballroom Dance Club of Charleston welcomes
Sheela Agrawal and Jason Creel to our Monday night
class line-up. Sheela and Jason will be teaching
Night-Club Two-Step on Monday nights at 8 pm.
beginning in Feb. This Monday night class will be a
great way to start your week and spend our less than
perfect February weather!

An easy-going social dance, N.C. Two-Step was first introduced in the 80's by Buddy Schwimmer. Nightclub Two-Step is normally danced to medium-tempo pop songs and ballads, using combinations of Slow-Quick-Quick and Quick-Quick-Slow rhythms. Although it is competed as a country-dance it is also danced to R&B, easy listening, and smooth jazz music. Night Club Two-Step can travel around the dance floor, stay as a stationary dance, or a combination of the two styles. It is smooth, romantic, and yet relaxed. This will be a class for everyone and will be a great addition to our February line up of classes.

Every month Sheela and Jason will be offering a new dance sequence and in April, they will be joining our Friday Night Progressive Series with Country Two-Step. A talented and very accomplished duo, Sheela and Jason are a great addition to our class offerings.

On Thursday nights at 8:00, David Roland will be teaching technique classes that will alternate on a monthly basis from Smooth Technique to Rhythm Technique.

David is a master at helping all levels of dancers correct form and function to maximize ease and enjoyment in dance. In February he will begin with Smooth Technique and will choose techniques common to all smooth dances with a weekly emphasis on a different smooth dance.

In March he will provide the same for the Rhythm dances. Sometimes called the "Dance Doctor", David has immense skill in identifying and helping dancers correct issues that interfere with their dancing. This will be a high value class for all dancers.

Monthly dance classes

The monthly group classes are structured so that there is a different dance featured each month.

Every week, the instructor reviews the previous weeks and adds a new pattern. This repetitive method is very effective. Because it is a progressive class, it is important to start on the first week of the month to avoid having to catch up with the rest of the class, thereby slowing their progress.

Beginning dance classes teach the basic frame and body positions, a breakdown of the basic rhythm and steps. This class is open enrollment, with either a reduced rate by the month at \$30 for 4 weeks or by the week at \$10. February class is Rumba.

<u>Fridays</u> February has been reserved for a series of 4 Rumba lessons with Debbie. These are progressive, meaning that every week the previous weeks are reviewed and new patterns added. There is an hourlong lesson from 7:30 to 8:30 and then a dance party. Admission for the lesson and the party is the usual \$5 for members and \$10 for guests.

<u>Saturdays</u> Lessons vary every week--see the calendar for details. There is an hour-long lesson before the regular dance AND it is included in the price of party admission! Snack food, sodas, and coffee are included as well. Admission is \$5 for members and \$10 for guests.

<u>Sundays</u> There is a Charleston and Lindy Swing Lesson at 6:00 and parties include a great band most of the time. While they do focus on the Charleston and Lindy Hop dances, there is always music for ballroom dancers as well. Admission is \$5 for members and \$10 for guests.
