





The Winter Frolic Competition this year held at the festively bedecked Goldcoast Ballroom, the creation of the very artistic Jeff Chandler, attracted competitors who have noticeably acquired greatly improved dancing skills, hence, were much better dancers this year. Three new very talented young couples who dazzled the spectators gave an impetus to the contestants and energized the day's performances.

Saint Valentine's Day or the Feast of Saint Valentine February 14

It is celebrated in many countries around the world, although it remains a working day in most of them.

St. Valentine's Day began as a liturgical celebration of one or more early Christian saints named Valentinus. The most popular martyrology associated with Saint Valentine was that he was imprisoned for performing weddings for soldiers who were forbidden to marry and for ministering to Christians, who were persecuted under the Roman Empire. During his imprisonment, he is said to have healed the daughter of his jailer, Asterius. Legend states that before his execution he wrote her a letter "from your Valentine" as a farewell. Today, Saint Valentine's Day is an official feast day in the Anglican Communion, as well as in the Lutheran Church.

The day was first associated with romantic love in the circle of Geoffrey Chaucer in the High Middle Ages, when the tradition of courtly love flourished. In 18th-century England, it evolved into an occasion in which lovers expressed their love for each other by presenting flowers, offering confectionery, and sending greeting cards (known as "valentines").

Valentine's Day symbols that are used today include the Heart, "heart-shaped outline," doves, and the figure of the winged Cupid. Since the 19th century, handwritten valentines have given way to mass-produced greeting cards.

Susan B. Anthony Day

February 15, 1820 is Susan B; Anthony's birthday, a commemorative day to celebrate the accomplishments of a great leader in the movement for women's right to vote.

In the state of Wisconsin, Susan B. Anthony Day is an established state holiday, which was enacted into law April 15, 1976, from the 1975 Laws of Wisconsin. Likewise, this holiday is also commemorated in Florida as a legal state holiday. In West Virginia, this day is celebrated on Election Day on even years but is not celebrated at a national level.

According to an article from the Seattle Times in 1985, the feminist movement is pushing hardest for this holiday to be celebrated nationally. (Other holidays that are not commemorated on an official federal level in the U.S. but widely observed are St. Patrick's Day and Arbor Day.)

Susan Brownell Anthony was born February 15, to Daniel and Lucy Anthony in Adams, Massachusetts.

Washington's Birthday/President's Day

Observed on the third Monday in February February 17, 2014

The Washington's Birthday public holiday is more commonly referred to as Presidents Day in the United States and is dedicated to honoring George Washington, the first president of the United States.

It is considered to be the first public holiday declared specifically to celebrate the life and accomplishments of one individual.

As a federal holiday, Washington's Birthday gives non-essential federal employees the opportunity to take a day off in observance of the holiday. Schools are also closed and there is no postal service on this date. Most businesses stay open during the Presidents Day holiday.

Schools often dedicate class work to George Washington around the time of his birthday, and townships may provide events that teach residents about the importance of Washington's contributions to the formation of the United States.

The holiday has been observed on a Monday since 1971. This ensures that federal employees and schoolchildren will be allowed to have a day off of work and school if Washington's actual birth date falls on a weekend.

The United States Senate has a long-standing tradition to read George Washington's Farewell Address every year in observance of his birthday. This tradition first started in 1862 and is still being practiced.

George Washington's actual birthday was February 22, 1732. Because the observed date of Washington's Birthday is now set for the third Monday in February, it is impossible for the holiday to ever fall on the Washington's actual birthday.






