



# You might ask yourself: "What happens at an OUTREACH EVENT?"

For those venues with mostly older persons as our audience, the event normally consists of about **one hour of playing music and dancing for and with the residents**. We solicit volunteers, who must be members of USA Dance, any chapter, to join us at the event and normally 10-18 members attend. The music includes all types of ballroom dance music, both Latin and smooth. We sometimes throw in a line dance and/or a "mini-mixer."

Volunteers need NOT be proficient dancers; beginners are always welcome. If volunteers are not familiar with a particular dance or just want to "sit one out," we encourage them to hold the hands of the residents and sway with the music. Many of the residents get very little physical contact and the OUTREACH EVENT is a highlight for their day or even their week.

# It's So Easy.....

to support our local arts organizations

When you choose Florida's "State of the Arts" license tag for your vehicle, all of the proceeds fund visual and performing arts programs (like ours) right here in Volusia County.

How much does it cost? The first-time cost of a State of the Arts plate is \$32 in addition to your vehicle's normal registration fee at time of renewal.

Of that, \$20 is tax deductible. Future renewals are only \$22 each year in addition to the normal registration fee with \$20 again being tax deductible.

To re-order:At renewal, simply state you would like a "State of the Arts" plate and include a check for \$32 along with your renewal notice.

Visit your local tag office, turn in your current plate and receive your new "Arts Plate" on the spot for \$32. Gift certificates for State of the Arts plates are also available at your local tag office and make great gifts that also help our community.

hear someone say, "Where is Ben?" Yes, we are referring to Ben Taylor. You might think of Ben as a dedicated dancer, socialite and friend, but there is so much more for you to admire.

He is one of our well-decorated Veterans. He joined the U.S. Navy in 1962 and served in Vietnam. As a Navy Reserve Civil Engineering Officer, he was recalled to active duty and was deployed to Afghanistan in 2003. Being an over-achiever, he rose in rank from an enlisted sailor to Chief Petty Officer and during his tenure earned the rank of Lieutenant Commander.

He served in the Navy for 26 1/2 years. During his tenure as a Sea Bee, he


made his way to the Admiral's staff in Washington DC and served as the enlisted training officer for all incoming Sea Bees.
