





While at Kings Bay, Felix was part of the Navigation Team on the US Canapus supply ship. The primary responsibility of this now Quarter Master II was to guide his ship in and out of Port. Jacksonville. It was there that his first passion of Dance re-entered into his life. As they drove through Jacksonville, he saw a sign saying Universal Dance Studio and implored his buddies to stop and let him visit. His visit resulted in an offer of employment. He agreed to teach a few private lessons, a group class and stay for the studio parties. Since he was still serving in the Navy, his opportunity was limited to a few private lessons.

His reputation grew and soon he was referred to the Fred Astaire Studio. There his passion for learning and Dance grew. When faced with the choice of re-upping in the Navy or choosing a Dance career, Dance won! Under the guidance of the owner, he became the premier and best teacher in the area. He now teaches from St Augustine to Daytona in a busy schedule. We know him as an accomplished and knowledgeable dance instructor and originator of the Palm Coast, Ormond Beach, and Daytona Beach Classic Ballroom Competition.

When asked about his lifelong highlights and passions, he has many. His fondest highlight is the day his daughter, Alissa, dancing with her father became the US Pre-teen American Smooth and Rhythm Champion. He then watched her progress to the Ohio Star Ball with Misha (America's Got Talent).

Now, his daughter is his biggest champion because Alissa and her husband, Mark, have graced him with his pride and joy, grandchildren. If you're looking for Felix on a free weekend, he is playing with his grandson, River, and his granddaughters, Charlie and Chloe.

His life today is just riddled with highlights as he travels the country and the world with his love, Karin, competing and exploring the world via the vehicle called Dance.



There is so much more about Felix that impresses me. He is a great friend, a great grandfather, a doting dad, a caring dance partner to Karin, and, of course, a professional dancer and instructor with 37 years of experience.

When you choose Florida's "State of the Arts" license tag for your vehicle, all of the proceeds fund visual and performing arts programs (like ours) right here in Volusia County.

How much does it cost? The first-time cost of a State of the Arts plate is \$32 in addition to your vehicle's normal registration fee at time of renewal.

Of that, \$20 is tax deductible. Future renewals are only \$22 each year in addition to the normal registration fee with \$20 again being tax deductible.

To re-order:At renewal, simply state you would like a "State of the Arts" plate and include a check for \$32 along with your renewal notice.
