Well, let me introduce you to Dr. Karin Bigman, Oncologist, Dancer, and Theater Arts Dance Performer! This rising star dancer has already carved her name into the hallowed halls of medicine and now is conquering the intense world of

When you choose Florida's "State of the Arts" license tag for your vehicle, all of the proceeds fund visual and performing arts programs (like ours) dance.

Originally from New York, she attained her medical degree from Sinai College Boston University and then Mount Sinai School of Medicine in NYC. She chose oncology because she wanted to help people like her grandmother who was a cancer patient. Her grandmother was the biggest influence in Karin's life. It was as she blew kisses from the street to her grandmother in Sloan Kettering that she committed herself to her career. Remarkably, her grandmother was cured of her lymphoma but lost her battle to a related cancer 10 years later. She recalls as a chief resident getting a call that her grandmother was taken to the hospital and was in a coma. She left immediately and flew to Florida, arrived in time to receive a smile and loving nod, and a squeeze of her hand before her grandmother took her last breath. Just like in a movie, Karin knows she waited for her. She always instilled the fact that Karin could do ANYTHING she wanted to do, as long as she worked hard at it, and encouraged her to be a doctor! That's were her love and passion of oncology started. She has a passion and a calling for this difficult and rewarding career.

Her interest toward dance was spurred by one of her patients, a championship dancer with her late husband, who would tell Karin stories and show her beautiful pictures and newspaper clippings to see. Karin knew in her heart that one day she would love to do that.

As dancers often do, she referred Karin to a local teacher. Little did she know that was Felix Solis, now a large part of her life! However, her first real encounter with dance was a group Salsa class with Kevin Guerra. She says she was pathetic, no she reiterated, she was so horrible that she couldn't get the basic salsa step for a few months. But, her persistence kept her going to group classes despite her two left feet. Upon Kevin's recommendation, she finally took the step to contact Felix and take private lessons. Although, she tried to take the first step, she actually finally got to meet Felix on Halloween 2015 at Kevin's Rocking Ranch Halloween party where Felix's smooth opening line was "Will you take a selfie with me." The rest is history!

The dancing and learning was about to become intense. She threw herself into a regiment of private lessons, joined USA Dance, and found another passion in which to achieve excellence. Private lessons led her to Mini Match Competitions. Mini Match Competitions led her to DanceSport Competitions where she attained another major accomplishment dancing with Felix. She credits his continued patience and direction for her success in the Millennium Competition. She states it is not always about winning - it's knowing that she danced well that really matters. Ok, she admits, the winning is nice too! Now, she displays her plethora of trophies and awards for all her patients to see in her medical office!





As she experienced the Dance Competitions, she became enthralled with a dance form entitled Theatre Arts. Felix encouraged her to pursue this additional dance form and introduced her to Craig Smith, a World Champion in Theater Arts and now her Theater Arts dance teacher. She never knew she would feel so comfortable in the air. After taking one lesson, she was hooked! That was 6 months ago; and as of today, she can boast of her biggest accomplishment, The Best of the Best in Theatre Arts at the Millennium DanceSport in June! This being one of the largest DanceSport Competitions in the USA qualifies her to compete in the prestigious Ohio Star Ball this November.

So, excellence, passion, determination and accomplishment are the adjectives that define Karin. However, she is modest and compassionate; and, when I ask her to brag for me, she can only

right here in Volusia County.

How much does it cost?
The first-time cost of a State of the Arts plate is \$32 in addition to your vehicle's normal registration fee at time of renewal.

Of that, \$20 is tax deductible. Future renewals are only \$22 each year in addition to the normal registration fee with \$20 again being tax deductible.

To re-order:At renewal, simply state you would like a "State of the Arts" plate and include a check for \$32 along with your renewal notice.

Visit your local tag office, turn in your current plate and receive your new "Arts Plate" on the spot for \$32. Gift certificates for State of the Arts plates are also available at your local tag office and make great gifts that also help our community.
