

## Highlights:

- Responses received from 22 members at the dance on 4/14/13.
- People overwhelmingly want to continue to have food.
- Split on seating arrangements, but fewer tables edged out current set up.
- Cost was the leading enjoyment selection, followed by music.
- Respondents overwhelmingly enjoy the music selection today. A live band got some traction perhaps worth investigating for an annual event.
- Broader age range of dancers was ranked highest on need for improvement question.
- Workshop/beginner's classes took the lead in the outreach question, slightly.
- Mix of style of music was close but smooth edged out both Latin and rhythm.
- Nearly 60% of respondents were 40-60 years old. There were none 19-40 years old. Over half of our group have been dancing for years and take regular lessons.
- Only 4% of those surveyed feel like they need additional contact from the chapter.


#### **Frequency of Attendance**



#### Is the Atmosphere Welcoming?




