Children's Ballroom Dancing:

The Heartland Chapter is proud to announce its independent **DancArts 'N Children (D.A.N.C.)** program. Although similar in nature to other children's programs offered by Heartland in the past, **D.A.N.C.** will allow us to offer more lengthy ballroom dance instruction to children, with the goal of exposing greater number of children to high quality ballroom dance lessons for extended period of time."



The Heartland's cooperation with the **IPS school #48** is the first example of such a program. These ballroom dance lessons are being offered to **2nd graders** of the IPS #48. The current session taught by professional instructor Xavier Medina and supported by many dedicated Heartland volunteers will run for 8 weeks. At the end of the 8 week session, the school will arrange a **celebration with the parents**, during which the students will present their dance routine. We are working with the school Public Relations' Division to see if news coverage of the celebration is possible (by Channel 13 or Indy Star).



In time, we are hoping to expand our ballroom dance lessons at IPS to 12 weeks per semester, and to explore other dance lesson options for children, such as homeschooling, etc.


Heartland held its annual **Ballroom Technique Workshop** and dance party on **January 21**st. We had a very good turnout, and the weather cooperated with our plans.




