#### \*\*\* Ballroom Technique Workshop \*\*\*

Heartland's **Annual Ballroom Technique Workshop** is fast approaching.

Mark your calendars for **Saturday, January 21, 2017**, **from 2 to 6:30pm** at Starlite Ballroom.

We will have 4 lessons taught by **Rauno IIo and Jozsef Parragh**, followed by the evening dance party.

Tickets are \$15/lesson, OR buy 3 tickets and get the 4<sup>th</sup> lesson (and the party admission) free!! (full-time students pay \$30 for 4 lessons and party).

#### **Ballroom Dance Lessons for Kids:**

The Heartland Chapter of USA Dance is launching an **8-week ballroom dance program** with **IPS school #48**, starting with the 2nd week of Winter 2017 semester. We are very excited about this opportunity!

The ballroom dance lessons will be offered to **2nd graders**, and will take place on **Thursdays**, **1:30pm-2:10pm**, beginning with **January 12th**, **2017**.

At the end of the 8 week session, the school will arrange a **celebration with the parents**, during which the students will present their dance routine.

We will work with the school Public Relations' Division to see if the news coverage of the celebration is possible (Channel 13 or Indy Star).

Xavier Medina will be our Professional ballroom dance instructor for this session.

There will be ~40 kids in our ballroom dance class.

We have a wonderful group of ladies who signed up as **volunteers for this session**: Jane Perry, Sandra Elliot, Susan Hoppe, Susan Stewart and Dorit Tomandl.

Prior to the 1<sup>st</sup> dance lesson, the IPS teachers will conduct an **orientation session** with the students preparing them for the upcoming dance lessons. The orientation will explain to the kids that:

- dancing involves hand contact with your dance partner
- dancing is a lot of fun
- dancing is a good exercise
- listen to your dance instructor
- be courteous to dance instructor and to other students
- work as a team / help each other out
- don't make fun of others' mistakes

Ultimately, our goal is for everyone to have fun. We want to work with kids who are interested in dancing; and we'd like to rely on the experience of the IPS teachers to help us out with the discipline aspect of the classes.

#### 2017 Workshop Instructors' Bios:

#### Rauno Ilo:



Rauno is a co-owner of Starlite Ballroom. He has been dancing and teaching for ~30 years. Together with his wife Kristiina, they were **12- times Estonian Ballroom, Latin and 10-Dance Champions**. They were also **2-time** Undefeated all **Soviet Union 10-Dance Champions** and **World 10-dance Finalists**.

After moving to America, they quickly became one of the top professional ballroom couples in the country and were the grand finalists in every Open Professional Ballroom Championships they entered. That included third place finish in the US National Ballroom Championships. They were also United States "Top Professional Ballroom Couple Of The

Year" for three years in the row.

After retiring from professional competitions, Rauno continues to actively participate in Pro-Am competitions with his students. He has been the Top Teacher in the US Championships for three consecutive years and has also won DanceSport Series Top Teacher Award twice.

Rauno teaches all styles of ballroom dancing in all levels (Bronze, Silver, Gold and Open).

#### His students have won ~ 100 National Titles and 7 World Champion Titles.

Rauno is a Dual Fellow of the ISTD (Imperial Society of Teachers of Dancing) and Championship Certified in all forms of ballroom dancing. He is also World Class adjudicator and continues to judge competitions and coach dancing across the country.

Jozsef Parragh started dancing **Acrobatic Rock n' Roll** in Budapest, Hungary at age 17. As he continued to dance, he discovered Ballroom dancing and realized he had found his passion. Jozsef began training in his home country and then moved to Italy, where he trained for two years. His teachers include professionals from not only Hungary and Italy, but also from Russia, Germany and North America.

Jozsef participated in numerous Hungarian Championships and won the Hungarian title 13 times. He was also proud and honored to represent his home country by placing 7th in the World Amateur 10-Dance Championships.

Today, Jozsef enjoys teaching people of all ages to become better quality dancers by connecting with and expressing the best parts of themselves.


