Survey results:

Survey Says...

Several months ago, Heartland provided a Quality/Interest Survey for attendees to complete. The Board's intent—by gathering ratings and comments—is to determine perceived strengths and weaknesses and maintain and improve as necessary.

21 surveys were completed and returned. The ratings were consistent, suggesting that the information was probably an accurate reflection of general opinion. Sixteen survey items were listed, with the following rating options available: (1) poor, (2) fair, (3) good, (4) very good, (5) excellent.

Approximately 75% of the rankings fell in the "very good/excellent" category; of the remaining 25%, most were "good." No "poor" rankings were selected in any survey. The most common use of N/A (9 total) was on the technique workshop.

- Items such as the following were listed on the survey...

...facility...music...hospitality...instructors/lessons...admission price...refreshments...

theme/special dances...communications...annual workshop...community exhibitions...

volunteer appreciation...interaction with other dance groups...overall Board performance...

overall satisfaction.

The only recurring negative item was the music. One comment indicated that the music was too loud. Others requested more contemporary music. Otherwise, the comments were usually positive

- Other info gleaned from the surveys showed the following...

...Roughly half of the responses were members...most had danced/taken lessons for at least 7+ years...most danced at least once a week and most attended the USA Dance parties multiple times per year...Of the preferred dances, Latin/Rhythm tended to be preferred (Cha-cha, Rumba, Swing) with some Standard/Smooth (Waltz) however virtually all of the dances had been preferred by someone

With the information collected, the Board will strive to “accentuate the positive” and “eliminate the negative” wherever possible in an effort to provide a good experience for participants in all Heartland activities. And as always, Board members continue to welcome suggestions for enhancing club events of any kind.

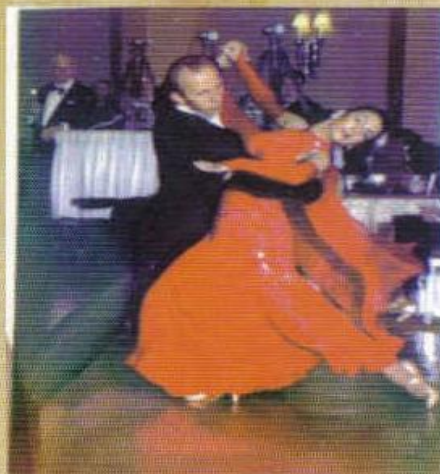
