Our second annual **Dance Workshop** will be at Riolo on November 9. This workshop will be a great chance to improve your dancing. Starting at 1:30 to 3:30 John Berry will be teaching American Waltz versus International Waltz and East Coast Swing versus International Jive followed by a practice from 3:30 to 4:00. From 4:00 to 6:00 Chris Ford will be teaching American versus International Foxtrot and American versus International Cha Cha. Another practice will be from 6:00 to 6:30. After that we'll have a break for dinner. The dance will be from 7:30 to 10:30. The total cost for the entire day which includes all 4 lessons and the dance is \$45. That's a pretty good deal with lessons from some of the finest instructors in our area. Don't miss this **great opportunity** and tell your friends. We will also be honoring our volunteers.

Starting in January 2014 all of our dances will be held at Riolo Dance Studio on the second Saturday of the month. Dance lessons will start at 7:30 instead of 7:00 and the dance will be from 8:30 to 11:00. This will match the Riolo times. We are hoping that this change will make it less confusing than alternating between Riolo and Starlite each month. We hope to see more dancers at our dances.

Our annual **Christmas dinner dance** will be Friday, December 13 at 7:00 PM. There will be no dance lesson that evening. It will be a pitch-in where everyone brings a side dish and the chapter

provides the turkey and ham. This is an opportunity to get a fantastic meal followed by great dancing. At our next dance we'll ask you to sign up for what dish you will be bringing. We usually get a good turnout for this event so plan to be there.

We are doing the **Annual Dance Exhibition at the Arts Garden again.** The date is the Saturday after Thanksgiving on November 30 from 1:00 to 2:00 PM. We need dancers to dance for this event. It's a lot of fun to dance and get cheered on, so give it a try. We had a good showing last time in September with several audience members getting an introduction to four different dances. We will be asking the audience again to join in and try dancing at this exhibition.





Heartland Chapter Volunteer of the Year - Larry Gogel

Larry is an integral part of the Heartland Chapter, and he is actively involved in many aspects of the everyday Chapter activities. He is very approachable and he does everything he can to make people feel welcome at the chapter events, and to help newcomers gain confidence in their dancing abilities. Larry has been a Heartland member since 2001 and a Board member since 2005.

To name the most important of his 2013 contributions:

- **Co-organizer of the Heartland Classic**. Larry worked as a Heartland Classic co-organizer in the past. However, the 2013 competition has been especially challenging. The original hotel that had been booked for the 2013 Heartland Classic ended up being double-booked and the organizers had to find an alternative venue less than 1 month prior to the event. Larry remained calm and focused while dealing with this crisis. He had to cancel all his personal plans for the remaining few weeks prior to the competition to ensure that the preparations for the comp and ultimately the comp itself ran smoothly.
- Co-organizer of the Heartland's 20th anniversary celebration. The celebration brought together 19 Clubs from different parts of IN totaling almost 220 attendees. Both events (the Heartland Classic and the Heartland Anniversary) were attended by the Mayor of Indianapolis and his wife who are avid dance enthusiasts.
- Co-organizer of the Chapter's annual Ballroom workshops. Larry initiated and organized the first annual workshops in 2012, and helped promote the event in 2013. The workshops are designed to bring in the best instructors in the field and to give the Chapter members an opportunity to learn from the masters at a very affordable rate. The workshops serve as a means of bringing together both the Chapter's social dancers and its amateur competitors. The workshops are also open to the general public.
- **Organizes public exhibitions**. In 2013, Larry organized and took an active part in several charity exhibitions, including Franklin county United Way campaign celebration and exhibitions at several nursing homes and retirement communities in Central IN.
- Organizer of the semi-annual Arts Gardens exhibitions in Indianapolis Circle Centre Mall. As is often the case, the exhibitions attract disproportionately more female dancers. Larry customarily dances several numbers with single ladies to make sure that all Heartland volunteers have a chance to exhibit their dance skills. He also dances with the people from the audience and answers their questions about the work of the Chapter.
- Launched Heartland's Facebook. Initiating a Facebook page helped the Chapter to facilitate contact with the younger audience and to reach out to several nearby universities.
- Launched Heartland's new website. The old website required the knowledge of programming skills and had limited space for digital files. The new website allows to store both pictures and video clips from the monthly dance lessons and special events. The Board got many compliments from its members on the ability to watch lesson summaries at their own leisure from the Heartland's webpage. While Larry receives help with website maintenance from other Chapter members, he continues to maintain the web Calendar and photo entries, and uploads newsletters onto the new website.
- **Produces flyers for monthly dances and special events.** Larry has an artistic side to him. He produces and distributes colorful flyers capturing the details of Heartland's monthly dance parties and special events. The flyers are customarily adorned with a dance theme and help capture the eye of the target audience. Larry prints the flyers and distributes them across several dance studios, as well as uses the flyers' electronic versions on the website and in email promotions.
- Larry is also responsible for mass emails to Heartland members. The emails include reminders to monthly parties and special events. It goes without saying that Larry is trusted with the safe-keeping of the members' personal information such as names and email addresses.
- In 2013, Larry renewed tax exemption documentation which saved the Chapter hundreds of dollars, both at the Heartland Classic and at the 20th Anniversary celebration. What might seem like an easy task actually took weeks as it required coordination with the National USA Dance Treasurer and the Indiana Department of Revenue.
- Larry negotiates Heartland's annual rental contracts with the local dance studios.

The Chapter will recognize Larry's numerous contributions by awarding him a Certificate of Appreciation at its "Volunteer Appreciation" dance party on November 9, 2013.
