Kathleen has competed at nearly every major Championship around the US, and last year was a United States Open Professional Rising Star Latin Finalist.

She was awarded Top Teacher title at the Indianapolis Open DanceSport Competition in 2014. She has also been part of the Dancing like the Stars professional team.

Our **Fall KDO session** took place on **Sep 29-30** and was very successful. We thank our KDO volunteers, John, Susan H, Susan S, Tina, Craig, Roland and Barb N, and our professional ballroom instructor Monica Lung for their time and help with the program. On Tue., Sep 29 our volunteers worked with 30 students from 2nd and 3rd grades from the IPS Super School #19. And on Wed., Sep 30 they worked with 40 students from 4th grade from the IPS school #2.



In celebration of the National Ballroom Dance Week, Heartland held **1 exhibition** in September that took place at the **Indiana Women's Prison (IWP)** on **Sept 26**.

We had 18 Heartland performers (ranging from college age to two 87 year old dancers) and over 100 people (offenders and staff) in the audience.

Heartland Board has been working with the IWP for over a year to bring this program to life.

Our dancers found performing at IWP a highly rewarding experience, and we even got a chance to dance with inmates during our group dances. The inmates' response was very enthusiastic; they were very supportive of each other and cheered on their fellow inmates. Afterwards, many inmates expressed their regret that they were seated too far away and did not get to dance with our dancers.

Barb Cameron, with her irresistible smile, became a star of the show. The audience also instantly took to Dennis Summers, our dance performer who also sang two songs, “The Way You Look Tonight” and “You Make Me Feel So Young” for our group dances. The inmates commented that his voice reminded them of Frank Sinatra. And when Roger and Amy Greenawalt, our National Amateur Senior champions, presented Bolero, there were no dry eyes left in the audience.

The exhibition program was very emotional. The inmates were dancing, crying, laughing... The inmates called our program “the best program ever featured for IWP offenders.” They thanked our dancers numerous times, and asked them to come back.

In turn, Heartland performers commented that it was a superb show, and that this was one the most enthusiastic audiences we’ve ever had. Some of our dancers admitted afterwards that they had had their doubts whether this would be a very receptive audience, and that they were proven to be wrong!

What is next? Heartland agreed to conduct annual ballroom dance exhibitions at the IWP. We are also contemplating offering volunteer-led ballroom dance lessons for inmates at IWP. If you are interested in becoming a volunteer dance instructor at IWP, please let us know, so we can assess the feasibility of the program.



About the IWP facility:

The IWP is a maximum security prison, and was established in 1872.

It is the oldest and first adult facility for females in the United States.

The facility runs several well-established programs including:

- ICAN (Indiana Canine Assistant, Inc.) in which offenders train assistance dogs for children and adults with physical/developmental disabilities.
- U.S. Department of Labor (USDOL) Apprenticeship Program. The partnership between the USDOL and the Indiana Department of Correction has developed into the largest prison apprenticeship training program in the country today. Registered Apprenticeship programs meet the skilled workforce needs of Indiana’s businesses by training qualified individuals for lifelong careers.
- Literacy Education. 34% of the incarcerated IN adult population is functionally illiterate. Increasing their educational attainment holds the promise of increasing employment opportunities at sustainable wages and ending a repetitive cycle of involvement in the State’s criminal justice system.

Heartland hosted a full hour of dance presentations and several dance numbers with the audience. Our dancers were amazing!


Special thanks go to Larry for taking care of logistics and ensuring that the program ran smoothly, and to our incredible MC, Candi!






