On January 21st the competition planning committee met to kick off its fundraising drive and to begin plans for the 2014 Gumbo DanceSport Championships. The group was very enthusiastic as we

began to lay the ground work for our most exciting competition to date. Not only are we hosting a national qualifying event, we are also hosting the Senior IV National Championships and the championship level of the Junior II Standard, Latin and Ten Dance National Championships. June 27-29, 2014, will be the Gumbo Chapter's crowning glory as many of the nation's finest dancers

will be gracing the Gumbo of Ballroom's dance floor. The Crowne Plaza Hotel in Baton Rouge is the site of this fabulous weekend of dance.




