USA Dance Gumbo DanceSport Championships

The 2015 Gumbo DanceSport Championships' recipe was full of hot sauce this June 26-28 as several national championship couples were present to defend their positions as the top couples in their division. It was exciting as time after time the full heats reminded those watching that the makeup on the dance floor could easily be national championship events. The competition was fierce and in some cases upsets hap-

pened, making for an electric ballroom full of cheering spectators.

The weekend excitement did not stop with the National Qualifying events, as this was the third year our team has

hosted the Senior IV USA Dance National DanceSport Championships. The Senior IV division is made up of couples sixty five or over. Now that may not seem exciting on the surface, but all four dance styles were well represented with outstanding dancers. Winning the Senior IV National Championships at the Championship level were:

Rhythm – Leland and Leslie Whitney of Saint Paul, MN Latin – Edward and Corrina Huang of Houston, TX Smooth – Leland and Leslie Whitney of Saint Paul, MN Standard – Winston and Lillie Chow of Atherton, CA

For the next three years Mid-Atlantic in Bethesda, MD will host the Senior IV National Championships and we trust that they will continue to nurture this growing part of USA Dance's competitive events.

For the first time the Gumbo hosted two WDSF (World DanceSport Federation) world ranking competitions. Senior III and IV Open Standard WDSF events were held on the Saturday evening of the Gumbo. Both events were heavily populated with outstanding dancers from across the US, Canada and Costa Rica. Hans and Ans Stork of Paradise Valley, AZ came in first in the Senior III event, while Winston and Lillie Chow of Atherton, CA won the Senior IV event. Both couples have represented the United States in World Championships outside the US and are ranked internationally.

USA Dance selected the Gumbo to be the site to launch its new Teacher -Student division of competition. Although the planners got started a little late in promoting the new Teacher-Student category, there was a good showing from other parts of the country as well as our own professional teachers. Nine teachers entered with one or more students with many of the events very competitive. Mixing these events with the amateur couple events added to the fun of the weekend, as many dancers stayed in the ballroom to cheer on their friends. This division of competition will no doubt grow rapidly, as the Gumbo proved that USA Dance has much to offer studios, teachers and their students in the way of a quality event, with highly qualified judging and lots of fun in the mix.

One part of the competition weekend that so many of us look forward to viewing takes place on Sunday afternoon, which is reserved for the young syllabus dancers. This year approximately 40 young dancers participated, most from the Lake Charles area. Thanks to the Whistle Stop DC Company and the efforts of its director, Nancy Vallee, young dancers are getting the opportunity to learn competitive ballroom dancing. There are a number of excellent dancers currently in this program, but the highest ranking couple is Reginald Larkins and Caitlyn Wilson. They were the local stars of the 2015 Gumbo, winning a total of 11 first places, 3 of which were against seasoned adult competitors. We love all of our young dancers and send them our congratulations for another great job at the Gumbo.

So many things came together to make 2015 our best year ever. We had competitors from 32 states, three provinces of Canada and Costa Rica with a record number of 348 dancers. In addition, many donors generously provided funds that allowed us to award a record \$18,000 in scholarships. And, with the huge crowd, our volunteer team did an outstanding job of making sure all attendees "passed a good time."

To all who work tirelessly throughout the year to make this event happen, thank you. To all who gave up their weekend to volunteer and be part of this great weekend of dance, thank you. To all of you who danced or were spectators, thank you. It was fun!


