NOTES FROM THE BOARD

- There is about \$3900 in the Treasury.
- The board determined the main responsibilities of four of the officer positions closely involved with the monthly dances.
- The price of admission for the 4th annual Tea Dance, being held Sunday, April 30th at the Lafayette Club, will be \$25 per person.
- The contract has been signed for the Grand Ball, which will be held Sunday, September 24, 1995.
- The next dance will be on May 13, place to be determined.
- There will be dance demos on April 4 (afternoon variety show for seniors) at St. Anthony/New Brighton Community Center; and May 2 at 7pm (for the Women's Guild) at United Church, St. Paul.
- David Schmit (College and Youth Chairman) has been working with Normandale, Brooklyn Center High School, Carleton, Macalester and the U of M to help organize and promote their dance clubs and activities, as well as arrange for dance demos and joint events.
- Nathan Daniels and Elaine Barrett have volunteered time to teach two Phy. Ed. classes at Brooklyn Center High School (the school requested ballroom dancing instruction for their dance unit)...
- We're holding another Taste Test fundraiser--we can eam \$450 for 50 participants; the money goes into the general fund.
- We will begin offering beginners dances. June Heglund offered to help with beginners classes, and we need people willing to coordinate the dances.
- Mark Tepley is the organizer for the Star of the North Games dance competition, being held June 25th from 12-6pm. Volunteers will be needed for help at the door, music, emceeing, and sponsorship. USABDA-MN will participate in the opening and closing ceremonies.
- The dance directories are almost ready to be reprinted. The old ones will be returned for credit.
- The next board meeting will be held Tuesday, April 11, 7pm at Dunwoody Institute.

USABDA stands for the United States Amateur Ballroom Dancers Association, a non-profit organization formed to preserve and promote ballroom dancing not only as an art but a healthy sport. Minnesota's chapter was started in 1991.





PROFESSIONAL PROFILE

FOCUS ON TWIN CITIES INSTRUCTORS

-Timothy and Michel Mason-

When you start dancing as a child, there's a greater chance that you can become a champion! That's the situation with Timothy and Michele Mason, who come to the Twin Cities from Florida once a month to coach and teach private and group lessons at the Twin Cities Ballroom and the Dancers Studio in St. Paul.

Timothy and Michele both grew up in the suburbs of London, England. Michele started ballroom and Latin dancing when she was four years old and Timothy started disco dancing when he was eight years old, then changed to ballroom and Latin. Timothy explained "In England, dancing is popular for kids — it's like a sport here! It's very common for children to start dancing at the ages that Michele and I did. There are many children's dance classes and school team matches."

Timothy and Michele first started competing with different partners. They have now been dancing together for six years. They competed in England for one and a half years before coming to the United States in 1990 to teach in a Fred Astaire studio in Manhattan, New York. After being appointed to the Fred Astaire National Dance Board, they started traveling to coach and serve as adjudicators within the Fred Astaire organization and also independently.

A year ago, Timothy and Michele moved to Florida. They are still on the Fred Astaire National Dance Board, along with working independently. They go back to England three times a year for coaching and competitions, staying about a month at a time. On their trip back last June, they were married!

Their list of championships is long – American Star Ball, Breakers, North American, Imperial, Texas Challenge, Virginia State, Empire State, along with being members of the 1993 U.S. Team to compete in the British Open in Blackpool, England. They also placed first in International Modern at the Twin Cities Open this past January.
