



# **Designing Dancers - A Member Profile**1063 Design

You may know them better for some of the other contributions to the ballroom dance world, but **Bruce Willits** and **Pauline Sanchez** have started a business that's turning to gold.

The idea originated about four years ago. Bruce & Pauline were dance partners for awhile and together, developed an interest in jewelry. Pauline had a background in jewelry, having owned a jewelry business at one time. Bruce's background was in design. They started taking classes in jewelry making and soon after, 1063 Design was born.

The name 1063 Design comes from the melting point of pure gold-- 1063° Centigrade. (That's 1945° Fahrenheit).

The concept behind their jewelry is to create pieces that can be worn anywhere-- from the grocery to the Ohio Star Ball. Worn casually it would give the person an opportunity to promote ballroom dancing. When an observer makes a comment on the jewelry, that opens up the floor for conversation about ballroom dancing and your love for it.

While they share much of the design, Bruce makes all of the pieces in his workshop. Just last year, he took 1st place in the **Minnesota Jewelers Association** Jewelry Design contest. Pauline does most of the marketing for 1063 Design.

Pauline is also the Administrator at On Your Toes School of Dance. Bruce is USABDA's Assistant Newsletter Editor and owns the computer on which this newsletter is done.
