USABDA PROFILE

FOCUS ON USABDA MEMBERS

GLEN LINDGREN & CHRISTINE McMONIGAL

Dancing has an amazing way of drawing two people together. Glen & Chris are yet another example of that.

They met at the **University of Minnesota** while dancing a formation, though not as partners. (Chris actually danced with **Tom Crable** in that formation which performed at the U of M **Valentine Dance** in 1989.) They started dating in August of that year. Three years later they were married.

They've had lessons with **David Pease**, **Robert Foster**, **Mark Wiess** and **Shinya McHenry**, competed at **T C O** and **MN Open**, and been on five formation teams including **USABDA's Silver Formation Team**. Private lessons focus on what Glen calls "interpretive foxtrot."

Glen has some unusual ability to "see music" in dance. While not formally trained, he has a very high musical aptitude and can picture exactly how a piece of music should (or could) look as it's danced. If you were at the **Dancers Studio Holiday Dance**, you saw the combined efforts of Glen and Shinya to a **Sinoxtrot** (That's Glen's word for a Sinatra foxtrot.) He says that, "What dancing is to me is deeper than simply what I like or don't like. The music drives me. Choreographing is my ultimate goal."

For Chris, her goals are less lofty, the main one being continual growth and improvement. She's somewhat reticent on competition, but really big on the concept of partner dancing. "Dancing at its best mimics love or a relationship. Two people come together in each other's arms and it's romantic. Just like relationships it has its ups and downs, but it's kind of the ultimate."

Besides dancing Glen & Chris enjoy attend art & craft shows and travel. Chris racks up thousands of miles with her job and they use those frequent flier miles for their own vacations. Their best trip was to Cannes in the South of France staying at the well-known Carlton Ritz on the Mediterranean. The suite had *three* bathrooms. Their home is in Edina, no pets or kids. Glen is an engineer at Osmonics, Chris is in Marketing at Digi International.
