# Ballroom Dance Competition RECOGNIZED BY NDCA

#### Bigger is Busier at 14th Minnesota Open

A new venue and new later dates seem to have added that extra something to the Fourteenth Minnesota Open Ballroom Dance Competition. The Radisson Hotel in St. Paul was a good host. Their food service was excellent. But, in a year when the Minnesota Open had the largest entry ever (over 1200, maintaining the leadership position it has always held) the turnout for the featured Amateur, Pro/Am and Pro events was a bit slimmer than usual. However, the quality of the dancing was very good. This year saw studios from Edmonton, Alberta, and Ottawa, Ontario (Canada's capitol city) joining those from Winnipeg, Manitoba, Omaha, NE, Fargo, ND, Chicago, IL, Madison, WI, Los Angeles, CA, Miami, FL. and our many Duluth and Twin Cities studios. Over 200 competitors contributed their talents to what was a truly fine event.

The judges were tough but very fair. Enrique Ramon chaired the panel which included Gilbert Wenham, Cynthia Dostal Long, Robert Long, Carrie & David Kloss, and Pierre Allaire & Mireille Veilleux. Jeff Carlsen served admirably as Scrutineer. The Minnesota Open is organized annually by Arlene & Bill Kroll.

Nels Petersen, who was in Blackpool the week preceding the event, made it back in time to dance and win both the Amateur International Standard and American Rhythm titles with partners Heidi Smith and Theresa Kimler. Gary & Carol (Post) Stroick won the Amateur American Smooth crown.

In Pre-Championship events Andrew Nordberg & Janie Sorheim took American Rhythm, Tom Yu & Daira Bui of Freeport, IL, took the Standard, Mark Tepley & Karen Kettler triumphed in the American Smooth, and, Freddie Marsh-Lott & Lindsey Seabrook from Madison, WI, captured the International Latin title.

Pro/Am winners included **Pat Kingston** in Ladies American Smooth, and **Jim Baker** in the Men's American Smooth, **Sue Lakso** in Ladies American Rhythm, and **Shirley Madill** of Winnipeg in the International Standard.

Selected Amateur and Pro/Am winners follow, but everyone who danced was a winner in our book.
