



Welcome from the President




Presidents Message







Letter to the Editor

Tony Jambor's retirement and sale of the Bel Rae Ballroom mark the end of an era. His departure leaves a major void in the Twin Cities. Unfortunately, ballroom dancers helped hasten this loss.

We hear news reports that ballroom dance is growing, and some of the forces for growth have contributed to the closing of the Bel Rae and the concurrent reluctance of other ballrooms to host ballroom dances. Studios fragment the dance community by efforts to confine students to their respective facilities, which seems shortsighted and inefficient-studios limit public recognition, and students pay more and get less. USABDA has often promoted the studio dance rather than general, social dancing at public ballrooms.

The dance world is changing, and unless USABDA and the studios take a different tack, those who depended on Tony for regular ballroom dances will disperse, hoping to catch the occasional big band at one of the few remaining ballrooms in the region.

USABDA PROFILE

FOCUS ON USABDA MEMBERS

MONICA MOHN



Few women dancers in the Twin Cities have been so fortunate. With some of the best partners available, competitions and titles have been won including several major championships.

Monica was on danceline in high school and at St Cloud State. After graduation, she wondered where ex-danceliners go to dance. A friend suggested Sundays at the Prom Center in St. Paul. "Wear a full circle skirt," was the advice, and, "Make sure you change weight on your feet with the beat of the music."

At one of the dances, she met **Nels Petersen**. That was over ten years ago, and they danced together for five years. Monica's next partner was **Hub Nelson**, with whom she won many competitions. In the latter portion of their three-year partnership they were undefeated, winning titles at the USABDA Nationals, United States Ballroom Championships and Ohio Star Ball, to name a few. But interests and goals change, and it was time to move on. Most recently she and **Bobby Tarnowski** paired up, winning USBC, Twin Cities Open, Wisconsin State and others.

Monica had to think about which title she got at which competition- it's clearly not that important to her. What is important is the audience. "When I get on the floor what's uppermost in my mind is the audience, to entertain them. When I'm in the audience I want to be entertained... we all do. Demos... they're so fun because there's no pressure. It's pure entertainment." Surprisingly, Monica is actually a little shy about her dancing. It was nearly six years before she'd let her family come watch, because it made her nervous to have Mom & Dad there. Which leads to a funny story...

Monica was an art major. If you've seen her perform, you'll notice her very artistic make-up. She considers it painting a picture of sorts. Often, people don't even recognize her... "I invited my parents to a competition once and my own father didn't recognize me. He walked right past and I had to chase him down and say, 'Dad, it's me! Monica!" By the way, her skills and artistry extend to her gowns as well. She loves to design and create them.

A well-rounded person, many other interests fill her life. She loves theater, movies, sci-fi and history books, and travel. She's been to several countries in Europe and recently returned from Egypt. She also loves to scuba dive. At USBC in Florida a few years ago (which takes place over several days) she used the days between competitions to get her diving certificate!

Monica is evaluating her dancing career and goals. She's been competing heavily for many years and now, just isn't sure what direction she wants it to go. 


