

Bobby remembers dancing as a regular part of social events as he was growing up. At family gatherings and weddings, in particular, people enjoyed dancing.

It all took a different aspect in college when he interviewed to be a part of a united effort for the road show, "Up with People." This was a two-hour stage production that Bobby participated in for a year. During the tour, which included the United States, Canada and western Europe, he learned techniques and showmanship that served as a good foundation for ballroom dancing.

In 1990, he started taking group ballroom dance lessons at Northwest Health Clubs. He continued those for about 1 1/2 years. When the Super Bowl came to Minneapolis, Bobby auditioned for the half-time show. He and his dance partner at the time, Mae Ng, were participants in that memorable event.

His coaching lessons are now from Jeff and Cindy Nehrbass. He competed with Cindy as a Pro/Am couple up until September 1993. The USBC was amongst those competitions.

He is currently dancing with other partners in various events. Donna Edelstein is his partner for American Smooth. Their first competition will be in Milwaukee this year. They are also planning to compete at the '94 USBC.

His USABDA Formation Team partner is Debbie Matthews. They will be dancing at the Theatre in the Round Players benefit.

His partner for Country Western is Lori Kozicky. They competed last year in the Tanya Tucker's Black Velvet Two-Step Showdown, taking second place in Minnesota, and going on to take second place in the national contest in Nashville, Tennessee.

Bobby says his other partner is also his biggest fan -- and that is his grandmother! Certainly his other partners won't mind that he is particularly partial to this one!

Bobby has lots of interests and enjoys sports like volley ball, softball, racquetball -- and has even tried cliff diving. He also likes motorcycle riding, camping and creative cooking.

On the job, Bobby is a Manufacturing Systems Engineer for Medtronics.
