PROFESSIONAL PROFILE

FOCUS ON TWIN CITIES INSTRUCTORS

-Tsha Jacobson-

Tsha's dancing career started at around age 10 with a blend of jazz, tap and ballet classes. Originally from Detroit Lakes, she went to Chicago after high school and spent about six months at **Gus Giordano Jazz Dance**. That's where her interest in dance really developed.

Tsha's local career started when she moved here at age 18 and took a receptionist's position at the former **Dance In The Park** studio in Minneapolis. She started teaching three months later-- mostly in ballroom, but also taught jazz, tap, etc. to children. She competed Pro-Am several times-- in fact, one of her first students was Hub Nelson! Tsha has worked at several Twin Cities studios and has now made her home at **On Your Toes School of Dance**.

In 1993 she and her then (and current) partner, Mark Weiss began competing on a professional level. Their best competition was at Ohio that year when... "we had the most fun costumes and went in with no expectations, just for fun. We were astonished to place 4th in the Rising Star competition." (Note: once a professional pair has competed and won in Rising Star they cannot compete again.) They're still competing and odds are that you'll see them many nights of the week training at OYTSD.

Tsha's favorite dance is the Cha Cha, although she says that she's probably best at funk and hip-hop. (No surprise that she even danced on the **Timberwolves** danceline!)

Apart from her professional career in ballroom she is also involved in a trio called **Fre Spirit**. (yes, with one 'e'). Tsha, Julie Bewick and Alyce Paguyo formed the dance team and even danced on the video for Viking's Head Coach Dennis Green's band, **The Sunset Music Band**. You can see that video on MTV, BET and The Box. They continue to explore additional opportunities to perform on video or at shows. Tsha has taken numerous voice lessons and would like to pursue singing in addition to her dancing.

For other fun she enjoys reading, writing, journaling and just spending time at home-- which is rare.

When asked what she loves most about dance?... "I really love to teach. It's been very apparent in the last year. My most favorite are my kids classes, because it puts in perspective my own dancing. Dancing is very selfish, it's all about 'me, me, me and what I can get out of it.' Teaching is just the reverse. It's not about yourself, but what you can give back."

FOCUS ON USABDA MEMBERS

-Noel Blair-

Is there anyone who hasn't heard-- or seen Noel? This lively lady has more energy than all of us! As USABDA's Director of Publicity she's the voice of the HOTLINE. She's also half of the well-known duo, C.R. & Noel.

Noel's folks were ballroom dancers and had numerous dance parties in their basement when she was little. (She'd stand on her dad's feet and dance with him.) He taught her the lindy, which may well be why she loves swing today. Later, he came to her proms to take pictures and then dance one dance with her. What a guy!

In the fall of 1993, some friends cajoled her into joining them at the Anchorage. It was there that she met C.R... they danced all night... and have been dancing ever since. What's so unusual is that they've never really taken much in the way of private lessons. C.R. won some in a garage sale, of all things, and then would invite someone to share them. That's how he learned, then he taught what he knew to Noel. They practiced whenever and wherever-- ballrooms, the kitchen, the living room. They've competed a few times, but their love is exhibition. Her favorite dance is Cha Cha; Swing is a close second, but they're enjoying smooth more and more. On occasion they'll take coaching to freshen or liven up their routines.

Travel is a big deal for Noel. When she and C.R. travel... "the first thing we look for is consignment shops and places to dance. We went to Europe recently and danced in London and Paris- to all American music!"

When not dancing, Noel does contract secretarial work for **Medtronic**. She's also an interior designer, through mostly for fun. She's big on flower gardening, loves the outdoors and walking, loves to cook and entertain, loves the theater (they have season passes to every theater in town) and loves to spend time with her two daughters, 25 & 27, and her mom. She also spends lots of time with C.R.'s <u>eight</u> grandchildren. Her two favorite things in life besides family?... fresh cut flowers and Kenny G music. Long term goals include learning Spanish and doing community theater.

As to USABDA?... "I've never met a more diverse and interesting group of people than when I started to dance. It's really neat."


