FOCUS ON USABDA MEMBERS

- JUDI PANKRATZ -

Most of Judi's early exposure to dancing was at family weddings and social events in high school. After high school, she recalls spending almost every weekend at the Prom Ballroom in St. Paul dancing to the Jules Herman Orchestra. She especially enjoyed the Silverbell Ball.

She stopped dancing for fourteen years during her marriage. Then Judi returned to dancing at her daughter's insistence that she go to Stark's to meet some friends. She immediately fell in love with country dancing as she watched the more experienced dancers glide around the floor. Judi admits that she was so taken by her new interest that she would go dancing at Stark's 3-6 nights a week.

After taking lessons for a year, she entered her first competition in which she and her partner took third place. Three years later, she competed again with another partner and placed in the finals in every dance. During that time, Judi was also taking lessons twice a week from Alice Monson.

Later, Judi found friends who were interested in ballroom dancing and West Coast Swing, so she included lessons in those dances along with her country dancing. Judi, along with Ken and Hope Lindquist, developed a tandem west coast swing routine, which they have performed at several events, including one of the USABDA dances. Judi is a new USABDA member but has already become involved. She did all the typing for the ballroom dance directory which was published last spring.

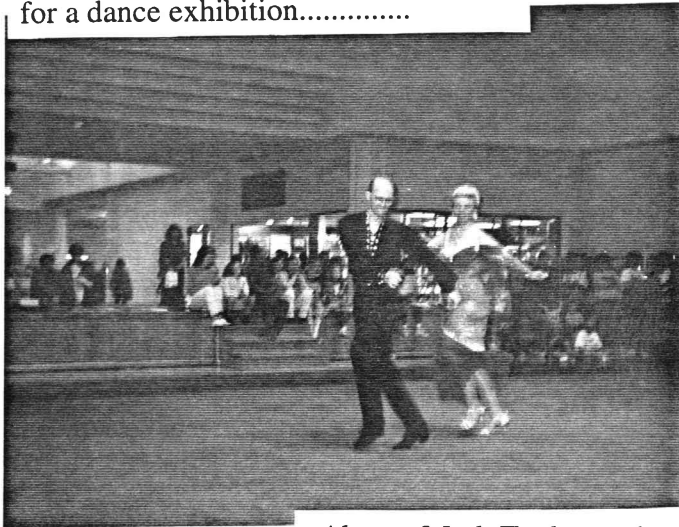

We were at Northtown Mall in Blaine for a dance exhibition.....



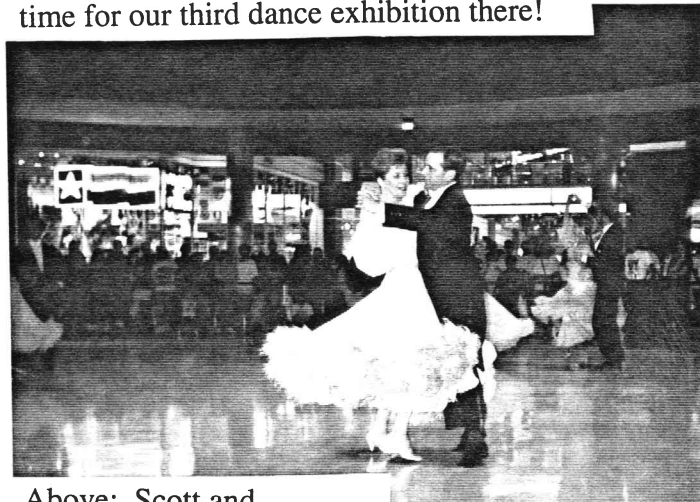
