

This is the fifth anniversary of the national celebration to educate the public about the wonderful health and social benefits of ballroom dancing. # NOTES FROM THE BOARD

- \* Treasurer's report: about \$3980 in the treasury.
- \* We will have the Grand Ball at the Hyatt Regency Hotel in downtown Mpls. on Sunday, Sept. 25. We'll have the same size floor as for the Minnesota Open--45x54 ft. We must meet a \$2000 minimum for food/beverages, then there will not be a room rental charge. Three couples will be selected for the professional show. A ticket coordinator is needed--tickets will be available for the dinner/dance and the dance only.
- \* Additional dance demos have been set up at the Minneapolis City Center, Brookdale and Maplewood Mall for National Ballroom Dance Week.
- \* An assistant music director is needed, especially to help with dance demos. Several people are being considered.
- \* Three officer positions will be open for election in December: First Vice President, Treasurer and Newsletter Editor, plus four director positions. We will ask for nominees in the newsletter.
- \* Food and cash donations from the August dance will be delivered to the Emergency Food Shelf Network, Inc. in Minneapolis; this is a statewide organization.
- \* The next dance will be Saturday, September 10 at the newly remodeled Sokol Hall in St. Paul.
- \* The next board meeting will be Thursday, Sept. 8 at 6:30 pm at Noel Blair's home, 7765 Spring Lake Rd., Mounds View, 786-5142.

Although dancing dominates most of her spare time, Yvonne is also pursuing flying lessons for single engine airplanes.

Yvonne has been a legal assistant for the past eight years and is currently working at a downtown Minneapolis law firm.

She serves on the USABDA Board of Directors and is a coordinator for dance demonstrations.

Yvonne's interview ended with this comment, " An abundance of talent in the Twin Cities area, including David Schmit, has enhanced my desire to become a better dancer."


