## Another Exciting Intercollegiate Event

What two exciting days are in the month of October? Halloween is the obvious first answer, but the second and more exciting answer is the **Twin Cities Intercollegiate Workshop!** The workshop is being held on Saturday, October 5th, as an all-day event at the **American Classic Ballroom**. Organized by **Elaine Barrett** and taught by **Sandra & Paul Botes**, the workshop will encompass mostly technique but will range over the smooth and rhythm dances. The day will end with a dance held at the American Classic Ballroom (**\$5 students, \$10 everyone else**) complete with demo's by some of USABDA's most prestigious dancers!

The Twin Cities are actually an ideal place to hold an event such as an Intercollegiate Competition, with over eight schools in and within driving distance. The Intercollegiate Workshop held last February, drew participants from Macalester College in St. Paul, Carlton College in Northfield, and Iowa State University in Cedar Rapids. Other schools with dance clubs that may come to the workshop in October include the Universities of Minnesota, Wisconsin-Madison, and Northern Iowa, the College of St. Olaf, and North Dakota State.

Workshops such as the one being held in October are in some cases not just fun and games for the students. Across the country, colleges and universities are joining together for intercollegiate competitions, the closest to the Twin Cities being the Dancing Illini Competition, this year on October 26th. Intercollegiate competitions are held much the same way that local and national competitions are held--individual heats in smooth and rhythm categories, sometimes broken into American and International, the team event, and occasionally extra workshops the next day. Most intercollegiate events even include an adult competition. There is also a huge international collegiate competition which rotates between Florida and England each year and includes several days of workshops taught by top professionals.

If you'd like more information about the Intercollegiate Workshop on October 5th, or you'd like to help the incoming students by providing housing (remember, these are poor college students,) or help out in some other way, please call Elaine Barrett at 789-2177. Even if you're not able to help out, please come to the dance at the end of the day to encourage the students in their dancing endeavors and help keep their eyes open to the wonderful world of ballroom dancing!

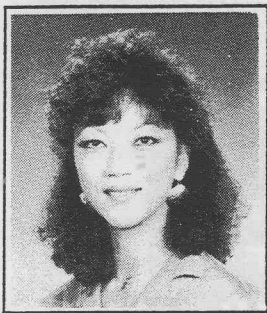
