We also had three excellent professional dance hosts come in from Jacksonville Florida in addition to our own Greg Nelson from our area to host for some of the ladies who signed up to participate in this opportunity. Many commented what a great time they had and the hosts met many of the ladies for future signups. As I stated previously, I have no way of knowing how many men will be available at each dance. Since it was so successful we may have this happen more often.
