Okay—this is a new feature to this newsletter. Occasionally, people ask questions about dancing. I thought it might be worth getting your two cents about this question. *Email me with your tips! I'd like to add YOUR two cents, too!* 

### "How do you decide what dance to do when you hear music?"

- Amy's two cents:
  - 1. Ask yourself what kind of dances can you do?
  - 2. Then, ask yourself, does this music "fit"\* into any kind of the dances that you do?
  - 3. Then, count to see if the tempo is suited to the dance that you think might fit. Do you think you can dance it at that speed?
  - 4. If yes, then, dance it!
  - 5. Alternate plan: see what other people are dancing and do what looks good to you!

\*"Fit" means whether or not the character of the music fits the character of the dance:
