INSTRUCTOR BIOS

GREG SIPE is the owner of “A Step Ahead Studio” in York. He has been trained by numerous well-known instructors in New York City, who have all contributed to developing many of the dances we do today. He has worked extensively with Dagmar Jarval, a highly respected judge of dance competitions, who produced many national champions and trained numerous top coaches.

Greg is a graduate of the Dance Masters of America Teacher's Training School in both Ballroom and Latin. He is a member of the International Society of Teachers of Dancing and also teaches movement re-education using the Alexander Technique and principles of The School of Body/Mind Centering. He choreographs routines for his students and choreographed the "Ballroom" section for the opening debut of the American Music Theatre in Lancaster; as well as many local and school productions. He is currently training students for their leisurely, social dancing as well as for professional/amateur (pro/am) partner competition. In addition, Greg gets great pleasure in coaching and preparing other professionals for their certification examinations.

OSCAR RESTREPO, founder and co-owner of BeyonDancing Studio, Mountville, started dancing at the early age of 14, performing in shows in Caracas, Venezuela. He came to America when he was 21 and began his formal dance training and dance career in the Arthur Murray Dance School, then going on to the Fred Astaire School in Tarrytown, New York, where he received his teaching certification at the Bronze Level in the American Style with a Highly Commended score.

Oscar has been trained by some of the top coaches in the industry, like Taliat Tarsinov, who holds 20 world and European titles and choreographs for “Dancing with the Stars,” Stephen Knight, currently regarded as one of the top dance choreographers in America; and Sasha Bylim, 3-time Ukrainian Professional Ballroom Dance Champion, with whom he worked for 3 years. He does many pro-am events with his students. In 2011, he won the “Top Studio” award in the Lancaster Ballroom Scrimmage and top teacher at the “Hooked on Dancing” event in Philadelphia.

Through all his years of dancing, teaching and performing, Oscar has realized that dancing is more than just steps. He works hard to take his craft BeyonDancing.

Lancaster USA Dance hosts a monthly dance on the Second Sunday of every month at the Farm & Home Center, 1383 Arcadia Road, Lancaster. There's a dance lesson from 3-4 p.m. on a different dance each month. Ballroom dancing follows from 4-7p.m. *Monthly dances are open to all skill levels. Beginners and singles always welcome.*
