

Christopher Allen teaches several levels of physics and coaches volleyball and fencing at The Masters School, a boarding school in Dobbs Ferry, New York. He has taught mathematics and science electives, and coached tennis at the school. Chris has a B.A. from Dartmouth College and a M.S. from the University of Maryland

Elona left Belarus, formerly part of the Soviet Union, at the age of 18 to come to the United States. In Belarus, Elona was three-time national ballroom dancing champion and placed ninth in the world. She started ballroom-at age 11 after starting gymnastics at four and beginning dance at six.

During her sophomore year in college Elona took part in a cultural exchange program and came to Stamford, CT. She is currently completing a degree in International Business at Mercy College.




