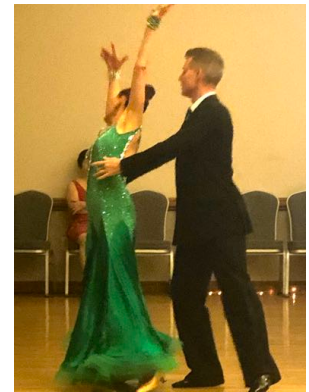

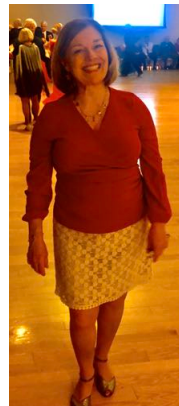

Refreshment Committee

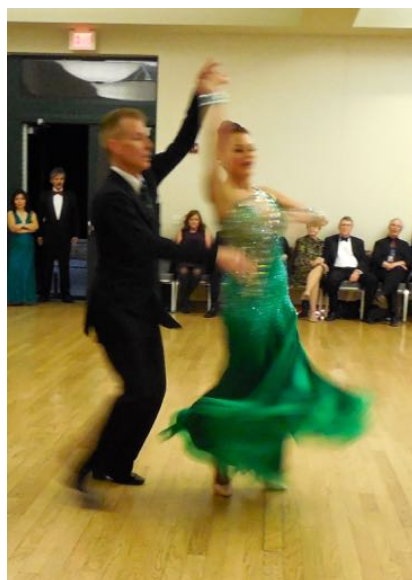
The Richmond Chapter is looking to form a “Refreshment Committee” to help coordinate the snacks we provide at our chapter dances at Deep Run and Rigby’s Jig.

We put on 23 dances a year where we try to provide snacks for our dancers. Over the years we have been fortunate to have a number of talented volunteers to help with this. Right now, we have a small group of individuals who provide refreshments for our dances on a regular or semi-regular basis. Karen Willis has been coordinating this for the 1st Saturday dances and Connie Nelms for the 3rd Saturday. Connie has indicated that she is not going to be able to coordinate at Deep Run in 2020. We’ve learned that it is too much to ask for one person to coordinate all of our dances so we need to take a new approach.

We’re looking for a core group of people who would be willing to be part of a rotation that would be responsible for coordinating the refreshments for one or more dances. That doesn’t mean they provide all of the food/snacks for that dance. They would be the point of contact to make sure that a few snacks were provided at their assigned dance. The more people on the committee, the fewer dances per person to coordinate – 24 dances and 8 volunteers would mean 3 dances per year per person. This would not involve stocking or restocking the supplies that we need at the dances. The Board will take care of that. We keep a bin of supplies for each venue that includes plates, cups, plastic utensils, serving spoons, platters and tablecloths. A Board member will inventory the supplies and make sure the bin is available for each dance. We also reimburse basic expenses for the food at the dances. The treasurer is on hand at each dance to collect valid receipts and write a check. We usually only provide water for drinks and keep water dispensers at both venues. We are also going to create a checklist of responsibilities to clarify what is – and what is NOT expected of you.

Our recent experience has shown that there are a number of individuals who enjoy providing baked goods or other treats for the occasional dance. Some do it for every dance they attend and have said that they will continue to help. The idea behind this committee is that some of these individuals might consider being on this team. Karen has agreed to act as the Coordinator for the committee. She would be the committee point of contact to make sure that the supply bins are in place and that there is someone lined up to be at the dance to coordinate the setup and cleanup of the kitchen and serving areas. We would make a schedule for this as we do for our instructors and DJ’s. The Henrico work crew at Deep Run sets up the tables and chairs and moves the bins from storage to the kitchen and back. At Rigby’s, it takes a bit more work as the tables need to be moved, but there are Board members on hand to help with this. All of this is a fun and fairly easy process, according to Karen and Connie. They both have people lined up to bring items to the dances and have the flexibility to do as much or as little themselves as time allows.

This committee of volunteers can grow as time goes by, but we need to look at what we are going to do beginning in January. If you are willing to volunteer to help or if you have any questions about the team or the procedures at our dances, please call Karen Willis at (804) 512-1606.
