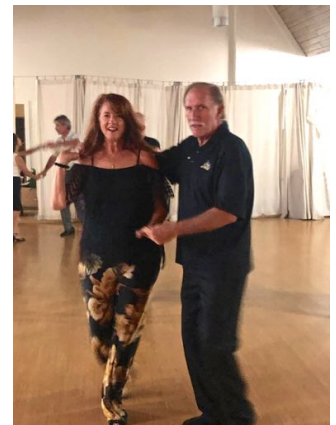
We would also like to give a big thanks to Mike Recant for providing great music to dance to all evening! Mike has a fabulous selection of music that really makes

## 2019 Volunteer of the Year

### Karen Willis



The criteria we use in selecting our Volunteer of the Year is fairly straightforward – we look for someone who goes beyond the norm to assist the chapter in its efforts to promote ballroom dancing and/or someone who makes a difference in the ballroom dance community by being involved in or committed to the expansion of ballroom dancing opportunities. Sometimes we are fortunate enough to have someone meet both criteria. This year we did, and your Board of Directors is pleased to announce that the 2019 recipient of the Chapter Volunteer of the Year is Karen Willis.

Karen, who works full time for HCA in their Division office, has been dancing for many years, encouraged by her late parents who were active in the “20 Cotillion” group for over twenty years themselves. After being away from USA Dance for several years due to work commitments and some health issues, Karen returned to the Richmond Chapter in late 2015 and became a regular at our dances and at local studio dances. Soon after that she also began supporting the Chapter in our outreach programs, helping with the JROTC cadets at James River, dancing in our group exhibitions at Regency Square and Virginia Center Commons, and dancing with residents at local senior centers. Her legacy membership in 20 Cotillion was also important to her and, when it looked like that group might have to fold after over 40 years of hosting dances, she volunteered to be the new president, actively recruited new members, and encouraged long-time members to stay, saving the club and continuing this “Old Richmond” tradition of holding formal dinner dances with

live music.

Another role she picked up again was assisting Mike Recant in his program that offers ballroom dance training to participants at the Virginia Department for the Blind and Vision Impaired. The DBVI is committed to providing quality services to assist Virginia’s citizens who are blind, deafblind, or vision impaired in achieving their maximum level of employment, education, and personal independence. Karen’s role was to partner with these individuals during ballroom dance lessons. As you can imagine, it requires a different perspective and skill set and Karen turned out to be a natural at making these students feel comfortable and confident on the dance floor.

Karen also volunteers her time and talents to assist two other local non-profits - the Greater Richmond Dancing Classrooms program, which introduces fifth-grade students to the wonders of ballroom dance, and the Elizabeth Kates Foundation, which supports female inmates at the Virginia Correctional Center for Women in Goochland. She helped organize the DCGR’s database to improve their community outreach, helped coordinate their last three Butterfly Ball fundraising events, and has served as an active volunteer at the last five “Colors of the Rainbow” team matches – the competition held at the end of each semester of the program. Karen has served on the Board for the Kates Foundation for decades, holding most board positions, to include a term as president, and is still actively involved on their scholarship committee which identifies deserving inmates and assists in funding their education so that they have a better chance of success when they reenter the civilian sector after their period of incarceration.

The most visible and visceral of her volunteer efforts to assist the Chapter is through her leadership of “Karen’s Krew” at our monthly 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday Dance. Soon after her return to the Chapter, she began offering to help Connie with refreshments at many of our functions. When the Board was looking for someone to take over the responsibility for refreshments at one of our two dances each month, she raised her hand – and her game – and it has worked out VERY well for those who attend our dances. Not only an accomplished cook, Karen once again demonstrated her recruitment skills and now has a “krew” of others who provide a dish or assist in presenting a wonderful assortment of treats at our monthly First Saturday dance.

In recognition of her donation of time and talents on our behalf, the Richmond Chapter is proud to honor Karen Willis as our 2019 Volunteer of the Year.

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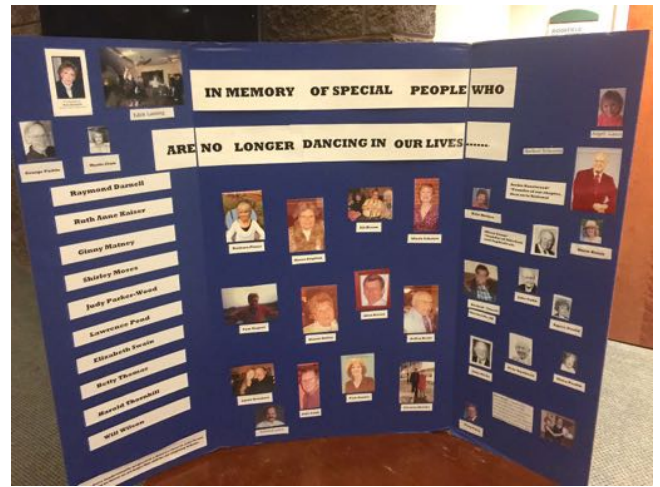

## Gender Neutral Committee (GNC)

USA Dance plans to make a long overdue change in the coming months – all their sanctioned competitions will be gender-neutral. This means that regardless of a dancer's gender, they are welcome to compete in the role that best suits them and all couples of any configuration will compete on the floor together. This change will establish USA Dance nationally and internationally as an organization that affords all dancers the equality, dignity, and respect that they deserve.

In Summer 2018, the DanceSport Council (DSC) first put out the word asking for volunteers who would work together to identify and address the necessary changes to make all USA Dance competitions open to what was then termed “same sex” couples. The newly formed committee consisted of amateur and professional dancers of all experience levels and various gender identities. One of their first actions was to adopt the term “gender neutral” over “same sex” in recognition of the fact that a competitive couple might consist of various gender configurations. That term has now been adopted industry-wide as other organizations have followed USA Dance in making similar changes.

One of the highlights for the Gender Neutral Committee (GNC) thus far has been crafting a plan for gender-neutral implementation that accompanied a USA Dance motion to the World DanceSport Federation (WDSF). The motion aims to change the definition of a couple from a “man” and a “woman” to “two athletes” to allow competitors of any gender configuration to compete, and to be able to represent their country at world championships. While the motion process is ongoing with the WDSF, the GNC has been encouraged by the positive feedback its rollout plan received from USA Dance administrators and by responses from other WDSF member federations.

Moving forward, the GNC has three primary goals:

- 1) To craft costuming rules that provide guidance to dancers, while allowing athletes the freedom to express themselves;
- 2) To establish an adjudicator training session to be held before the 2020-2021 competition season;
- 3) To work with event organizers so that they can easily make the transition to being fully gender-neutral.

On behalf of the entire USA Dance organization, the GNC is working hard to foresee all of the issues that may come up as USA Dance implements gender neutrality. The GNC recognizes that some dancers may not have felt welcome within the current framework, and welcomes questions and comments from past, current, and prospective USA Dance members regarding the upcoming changes. By giving all voices an opportunity to be heard, USA Dance can make the necessary structural and cultural changes within the organization.
