Happy New Year to all from your Board of Directors! It hardly feels like the dead of winter as the temperature is in the 70's as I write this just before Christmas. from their dancing that he was not yet back to 100%. I'm confident they will again be very competitive as they seek their sixth straight title at the national championships in 2014.

The Regency event was again guite successful. We presented a nice mix of prepared routines, impromptu performances, and group dances, with good participation by the holiday shopping crowd. The mall manager sent us a generous donation and a nice note of appreciation, which is quoted inside. Gabe Pascorella again did a great job of coordinating this event and even arranged for a performance by a couple from the Clover Hill High School Show Choir that was a real show-stopper. The Clover Hill group is the top-ranked show choir in the country and it was a real coup to get them to join us for a demo that was reminiscent of what you would see on Fox TV's mega-hit, "Glee". We hope to get members of this group for an exhibition at one of our monthly dances before the end of the school year!






