#### Volunteer of the Year

NOTE: The Richmond Chapter has recognized an individual as "Amateur of the Year" annually for over 25 years. In 2012 we changed the name of this award to "Volunteer of the Year" in order to align ourselves with other USA Dance chapters. All chapters are then invited to submit their selected individuals to be considered for this same award at the District and National levels for additional recognition for their contributions.

The Richmond Chapter's "Volunteer of the Year" for 2014 is Connie Nelms.

Connie has been a member of the Richmond Chapter for almost 15 years, joining shortly after she took up ballroom dancing following a dance cruise. She enjoyed watching the dancers on the ship and decided to look into lessons when she returned to Richmond. Growing up in

the Philippines, she was exposed to various styles of dance but did not seriously get into ballroom dancing until then. It quickly became a passion and she even began competing – and winning – in competitions across the state and country.

In 2006, Connie was elected to the chapter's Board of Directors as an At-Large member and became more involved in the operations of USA Dance. She and her husband, Bill, had owned and operated a home health care business for a number of years but sold it to their son in 2006 to allow more time to pursue outside interests. Connie quickly made an impact with her input in board activities and her assistance at USA Dance events and dances.

When the Refreshment Coordinator position opened up in 2010, Connie volunteered to assume that role. She began rounding up volunteers to help with the refreshments at our dances and "Connie's Crew" was born. This has been a labor of love for her as she says she enjoys trying out new recipes and meeting other members who enjoy making things to share at our dances. Another of Connie's many interests is traveling and dancing in other venues across the country. During these visits she sees how other groups handle their refreshment needs and gets great ideas to bring back to Richmond.

Last year, when the Richmond Chapter hosted the National Chapter Conference, Connie played an integral role in the planning and preparation for our visitors from across the country and even took on the role of gathering items and stuffing welcome bags for over 125 guests to our city. She also spent time at the hotel venue offering assistance and helping in the administration of the conference as a volunteer.

One of the draws of the Richmond Chapter has always been the high quality of the refreshments we offer during our events. These snacks – and occasional dinners – do not just appear out of nowhere. Connie spends a great deal of time preparing food, gathering supplies, and recruiting helpers to provide goodies or assist in serving and cleanup. Presentation is also an important part of how she views her role as Refreshment Coordinator and she takes great pride in how the table looks as well as how the food tastes.

Connie has done an amazing job as Refreshment Coordinator and in other areas of responsibility on the Richmond Board and for her contributions, talent and dedication to the chapter we are pleased to honor her as our Volunteer of the Year for 2014.
