

## Getting Down to Business.....

Now that we have taken care of the fun stuff, just a friendly reminder that members can renew their membership online by going to: www.usadance.org and on the home page on the top right

corner, click on "Membership Join or Renew". This is the easiest way to renew. You will need to use your credit card and have your USA Dance membership number ready. If you do not know your membership number, please contact Ruth Wilbourne Gandel our Chapter Membership Coordinator, and she will provide it to you. Contact Ruth at: <a href="mailto:rw4013@hughes.net">rw4013@hughes.net</a>. Yearly membership fee for the Social Dancer category is \$35. You can also renew at a 2<sup>nd</sup> Saturday dance with cash or a check. If renewing with cash, the chapter will have to deposit the cash to its bank account and then write a check to send to the National USA Dance. To skip that step, you can write a check to "USA Dance, Inc." for the correct amount and your check will be sent to the National organization. In either case, you will have to fill in the application/renewal form which is available at each dance.

An email notice will be sent to you by the National USA Dance Membership Director letting you know that your membership is soon to expire. If your membership expires, you have three months to renew, and if you have not renewed within the three-months, you will be dropped from the rolls. You do not want that to happen as you will have to pay the higher non-member admission price to attend our 2<sup>nd</sup> Saturday dances. Also, you will no longer receive the monthly Line of Dance newsletter, or the American Dancer magazine.
