ZIP LINE IN KETCHIKAN!

After a short walk into the forest, you'll be outfitted and receive detailed instructions.

You'll quickly discover that this is so much more than just a zip line tour. For those adventurous enough, there's an added option of climbing a 50' tower. Since you're securely attached to cables, even the less adventurous can test their balance here.

The seven zip lines encircle the course. You'll catch glimpses of the ocean below as you glide among the trees. Along the way, climb through a giant cedar tree called "The Nest" to the final zip line and descend back to the ground.



BUTCHART GARDENS- VICTORIA BC

The Butchart Gardens is one of the world's premier floral show gardens. Jennie Butchart began to shape this magnificent 55-acre landscape in 1904 from her husband Robert's abandoned limestone quarry. The result was the dramatic Sunken Garden, a reflection of the early 20th century beautification movement and an exceptional achievement in Canadian gardening history.

TOTEMS AND EAGLES TOUR- KETCHIKAN. This tour begins with a visit to Saxman Totem Village, the only totem park in Alaska that has 29 authentic totems carved by Tlingit and Haida natives. As you stroll through the park, your guide will explain the thriving native culture.

Upon leaving you'll find yourself in the midst of the rainforest. Identify coniferous hemlock, spruce, and cedar trees that have played important roles in Ketchikan's development. Your guide will also take you to an "eagle



tree." At the very top of this gigantic Sitka spruce is an eagle's nest. If you're lucky, an adult eagle may be perched on the edge of its huge nest!
