## **Directions to the Ballroom:**

**From Medford/Ashland:** From the Medford North Exit (Exit 30), take 62 East. Drive 1 mile past CostCo. Turn right at the light onto Vilas Road and immediately left onto Crater Lake Ave. Drive one mile. Turn right into Ironwood Business Park. The address is on the building: 6088 Crater Lake Ave.

**From Grants Pass:** Take Central Point Exit 33. Turn left onto E Pine. Go 1 mile. Turn left at the light onto Table Rock Rd. Turn Right at the light onto Vilas Road. Go through the light at Crater Lake Highway (62) and turn immediately left onto Crater Lake Ave. Drive one mile. Turn right into Ironwood Business Park. The address is on the building: 6088 Crater Lake Ave.
