Nine hundred people packed the auditorium at North Medford High School on November 14 to cheer on their favorite celebrity at the first annual Dancing with the Rogue Valley Stars.



The event was a huge success and the first of its kind for Rogue Valley. Ten local celebrities were paired with ten local accomplished dancers to compete for first, second or third place in the People's Choice Award (audience votes), and/or for the Judge's Choice Awards (judge's scores).

The sold-out event was a fund raiser benefiting Southern Oregon Sparrow Clubs and USA Dance Chapter #1011 dance scholarship fund. The stars and their dance partners practiced for several weeks before the event, coached by local dance instructors, who choreographed the dance performances.  3rd place Pam Zaklan Quickstep


Winners of the judge's choice were:


Dance Lover's Ball
