#### Youth Ballroom Dance Program

The *USA Dance Antelope Valley Chapter 4037* would like to *invite* your school district to participate in the "Dancing Feet," Youth Ballroom Dance Program. Teachers at participating sites will teach 5<sup>th</sup> grade students three ballroom dances, 6<sup>th</sup> and/or 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade student's five ballroom dances 2-3 hours per week after school or during school for 10 weeks. Students will be selected from each participating school to form a dance competition team. The team will compete against school districts at the 8<sup>th</sup> Annual High Desert Dance Classic competition March 9-11, 2012, at the Antelope Valley College. Trophies and medallions will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winning schools. The School winning 1<sup>st</sup> place will receive the Traveling Trophy to keep over the next year.

- **Program objectives and benefits related to students:** The program objectives are to provide students with an opportunity to experience the arts through dance. Ballroom dance gives students confidence, poise, and practice in relating to the opposite gender in positive and respectful ways. Ballroom dance teaches courtesy, patience, and teamwork. This activity is both absorbing and social which can be a powerful distraction from drugs and crime. Ballroom dance gives students an opportunity to experience the arts in a way that can last a lifetime!
